

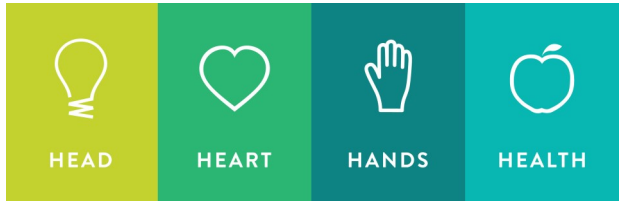
WHAT IS 4-H?

☘ **The 4-H** program begins at the club level. Our 4-H members, parents and leaders meet monthly to have fun, learn and work together in project groups, club activities, special interest groups, and many events.

☘ **4-H** belongs to the members, their families, and other interested adults who serve as volunteer leaders. Leadership is provided by the University of Wisconsin Extension Service. The 4-H program is a joint effort of county government, University of Wisconsin, and the United States Department of Agriculture.

☘ **4-H** is an informal educational program through which parents, other adults, and youth help young people develop confidence, social skills, decision-making abilities, and subject matter knowledge in a variety of project areas.
